SBMS EXPECTATIONS FOR QIMR HONORARY APPOINTEES

The School of Biomedical Sciences expects that Honorary appointees from QIMRB will perform the following:

- Where possible, acknowledge 'The School of Biomedical Sciences, The University of Queensland' as one of their affiliations on research articles published by the Honorary applicant.
- Assess Honours seminars and theses when requested to do so.
- Participate in HDR student committees when requested to do so.
- Contribute to school seminars when requested to do so.
- Honorary Level A and B appointees can only be secondary supervisor (i.e., not primary supervisor) for students.

When requesting a RENEWAL for an Honorary appointment, applicants are asked to provide evidence of the duties and responsibilities completed since the initial appointment/last renewal, including:

- The details of any SBMS Honours students they have supervised (student names and years' supervised).
- The details of any SBMS Honours students they have examined (student names and years' supervised).
- The details of any UQ HDR students they have been primary advisor for (student names and years' supervised).
- The details of any HDR panels they have contributed to for UQ students outside QIMRB.
- Provide a list of co-authored publications with these students. NOTE: as per university <u>policy</u>, UQ should be listed as an affiliate on all publications that have a UQ enrolled student as a co-author.
